READ BEFORE USING YOUR SLINGSHOT

Cleaning The Frame

Luke warm water with a **mild** soap is ideal for wiping down the frame. Dry with a cloth or paper towelling. This is all that is required to clean the frame. **DO NOT** use any kind of solvents or aggressive cleaning substances.

DO NOT DRY USING A HEAT SOURCE

DO NOT MODIFY THE FRAME IN ANY WAY

Storage. Keep frame away from glues, oils, solvents, polishes, heat sources and extreme freezing conditions. Do not store in direct sunlight. (Remember to store the slingshot away from the reach of children and minors.)

Damage To Frame

If you suspect that there is possibility of damage to the frame due to a fork hit or other impact source, fully inspect the frame and DO NOT SHOOT until you are totally satisfied that the frame has full integrity, with no apparent damage. Nicks, cuts, bruises & burrs to the frame must be treated in the same manner. Check. Do give your product a detailed inspection before shooting.

IF IN DOUBT THROW IT OUT!

Slingshots can cause severe personal injury or death.

REMEMBER ALWAYS - Wear safety glasses for eye protection.

Slingshots, their ammunition and possible band breakage are dangerous to your eyes.

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO USE this frame without fully understanding the safety requirements and techniques required to shoot safely. Do some research on how to aim (YouTube?)

Ensure you use an adequate ammo catch box or back stop before you shoot.

Beware of your location and surroundings when shooting - Are they SAFE?

DO NOT shoot at hard solid surfaces or water. Rebounds and ricochets are equally dangerous.

Slingshots should stored and kept away from minors at all times.

ALWAYS: Inspect - frame - bands - attachments & pouch for signs of wear or damage before EACH shot.
